
## DIRECTIONS, ARRIVAL, & DEPARTURE INFO FROM SACRAMENTO TO CAMP CODY



- Take Highway 50 East towards South Lake Tahoe and proceed through Placerville, Silver Fork, and Kyburz.
- Approximately twenty-nine (29) miles east of Placerville, you will begin to see brown and white Forest
  Service signs on the right side of the highway. Approximately twenty (20) miles from where Highway 50
  becomes two (2) lanes or ½ mile before Strawberry (forty-two [42] miles east of Placerville), turn right
  onto Milestone Tract 42. The Camp Cody mailbox will be clearly visible at the turnoff.
- After turning from Highway 50, watch for the red and white Camp Cody signs to direct you to the parking lot, which is approximately six (6) miles from the highway.
- Once at the parking lot, gather all of your equipment and wait at Jack Voss Trailhead and Trail¹ until given permission to proceed down the trail to Camp.

Allow approximately 2 hours drive time (moderate trafffic)

IMPORTANT: Be aware that the road from Hwy 50 to the trailhead is not routinely maintained. Expect pothouses along the paved sections of road (the potholes cam be hard to see when driving in and out of the shade). You will encounter ruts and rocks along the dirt portions of the roads. These perennial conditions are detrimental to vehicles with low under carraiges and sensitive suspension systems. Please drive carfully.
