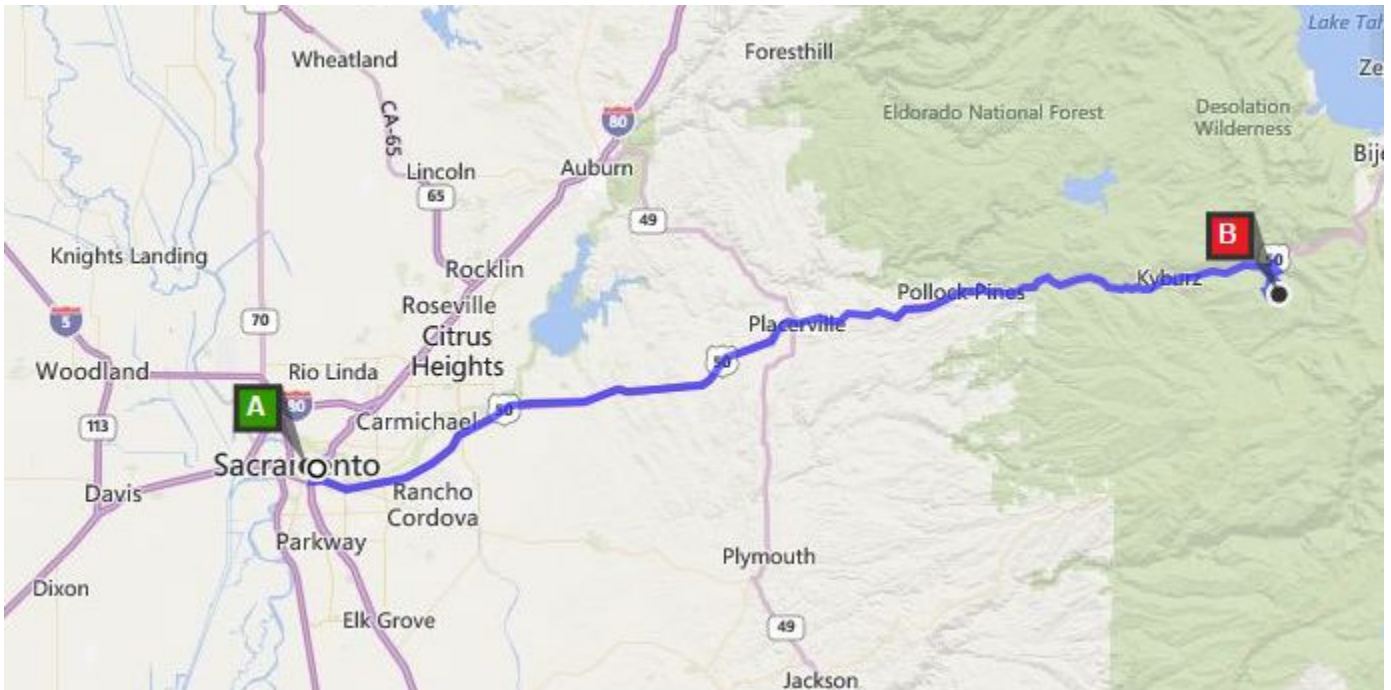


DIRECTIONS, ARRIVAL, & DEPARTURE INFO

FROM SACRAMENTO TO CAMP CODY

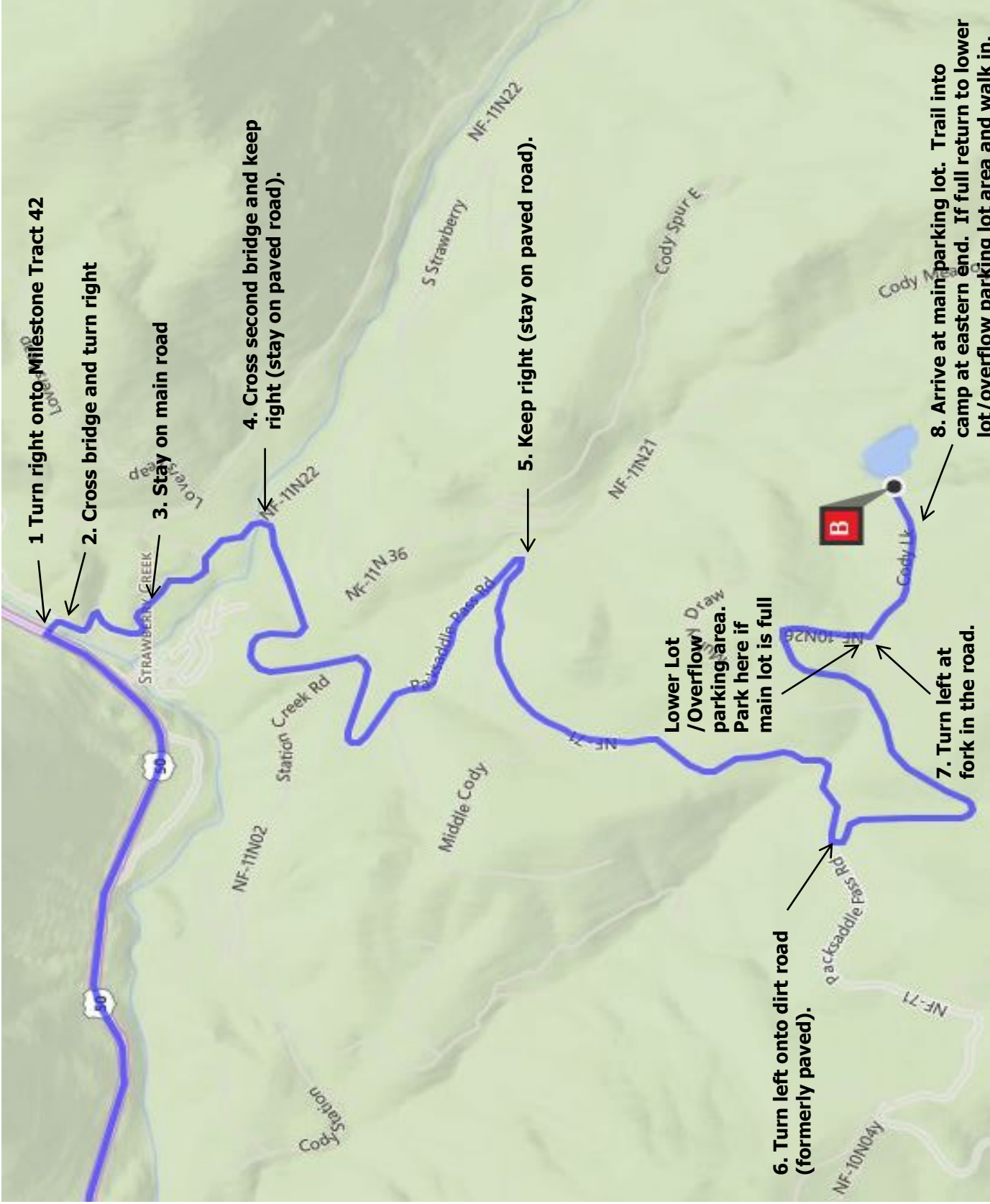


- Take Highway 50 East towards South Lake Tahoe and proceed through Placerville, Silver Fork, and Kyburz.
- Approximately twenty-nine (29) miles east of Placerville, you will begin to see brown and white Forest Service signs on the right side of the highway. Approximately twenty (20) miles from where Highway 50 becomes two (2) lanes or ½ mile before Strawberry (forty-two [42] miles east of Placerville), turn right onto Milestone Tract 42. The Camp Cody mailbox will be clearly visible at the turnoff.
- After turning from Highway 50, watch for the red and white Camp Cody signs to direct you to the parking lot, which is approximately six (6) miles from the highway.
- Once at the parking lot, gather all of your equipment and wait at Jack Voss Trailhead and Trail¹ until given permission to proceed down the trail to Camp.

Allow approximately 2 hours drive time (moderate traffic)

IMPORTANT: Be aware that the road from Hwy 50 to the trailhead is not routinely maintained. Expect potholes along the paved sections of road (the potholes can be hard to see when driving in and out of the shade). You will encounter ruts and rocks along the dirt portions of the roads. These perennial conditions are detrimental to vehicles with low undercarriages and sensitive suspension systems. Please drive carefully.

¹ On December 14, 2018 the Forest Service determined that given Jack Voss' contributions to our community, the Boy Scouts of America, and the Eldorado National Forest, the naming of a local hiking trail in his honor would be appropriate.



1 Turn right onto Milestone Tract 42

2. Cross bridge and turn right

3. Stay on main road

4. Cross second bridge and keep right (stay on paved road).

5. Keep right (stay on paved road).

Lower Lot / Overflow Draw parking area. Park here if main lot is full

6. Turn left onto dirt road (formerly paved).

7. Turn left at fork in the road.

8. Arrive at main parking lot. Trail into camp at eastern end. If full return to lower lot/overflow parking lot area and walk in.
