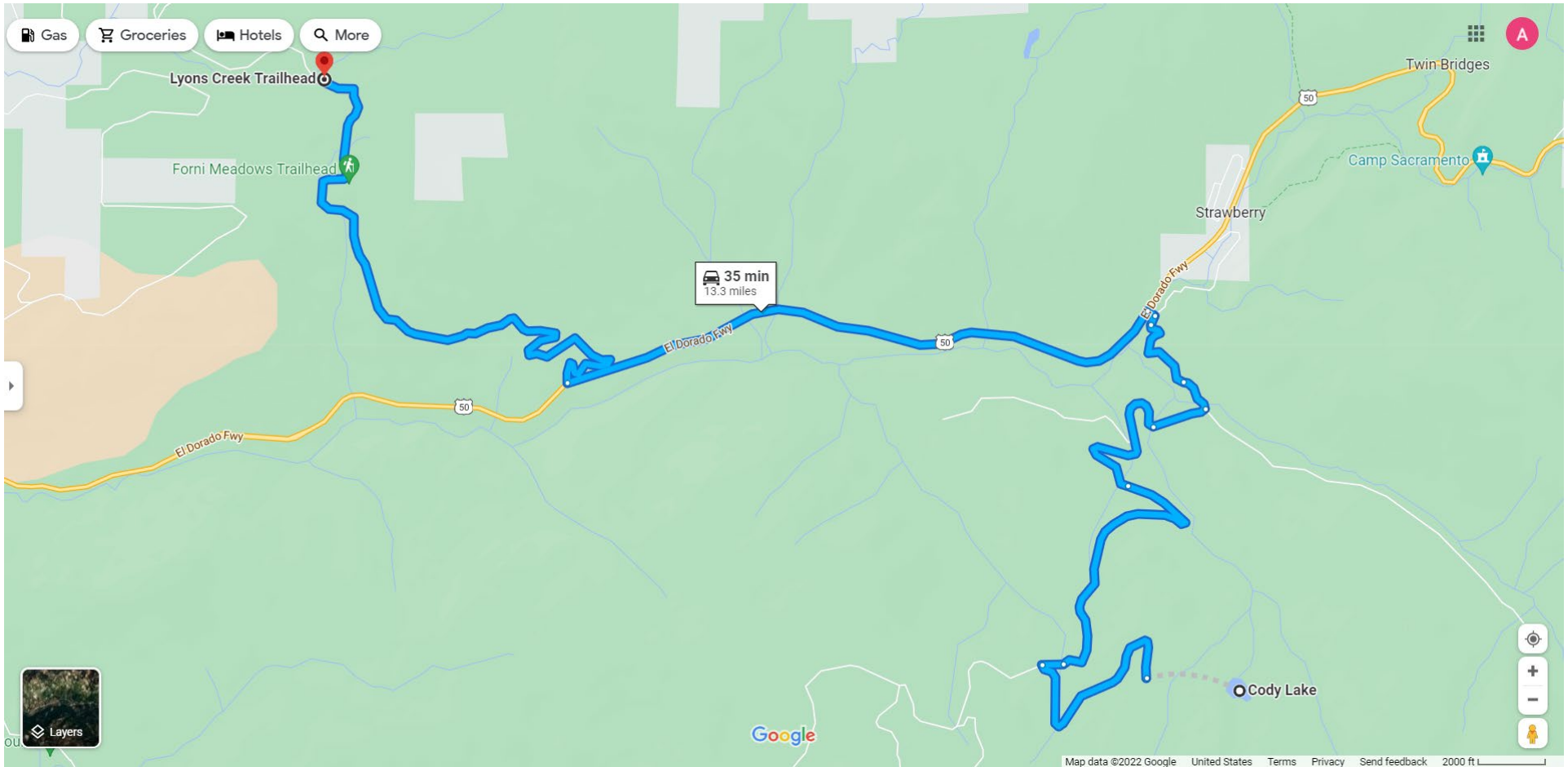


Lyons Lake trailhead



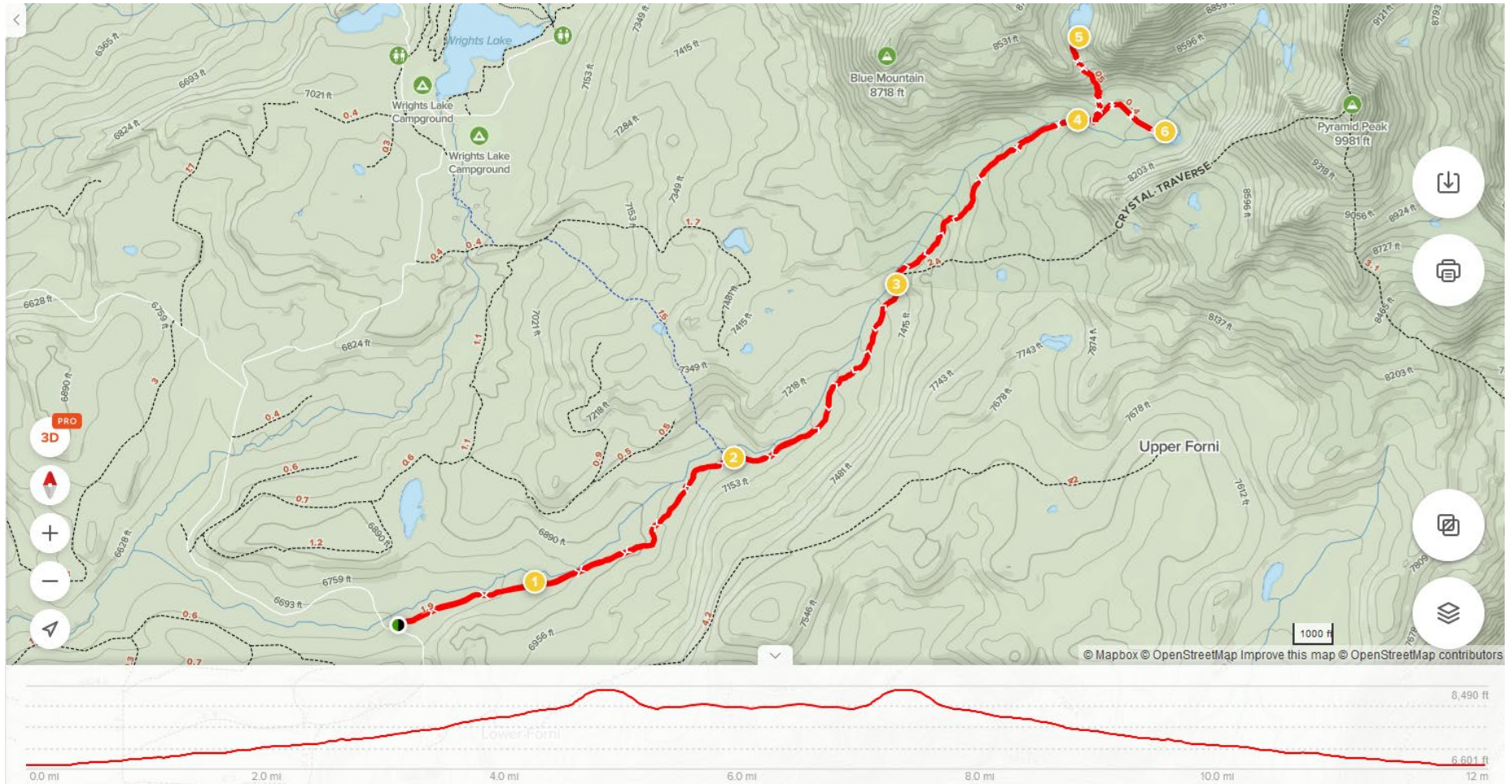
Driving directions from Camp Cody parking lot (38.759, -120.149) to Lyons Creek (38.810, -120.239) parking lot and the Lyons/Sylvia Lake trailhead. (If you continued driving, you would reach the Wrights Lake trailheads.)

Caution: Be aware that Wrights Lake Road has a significant grade and is a narrow, curvy road so be mindful you do not overheat and watch for oncoming traffic.

Driving distance and time to Desolation Wilderness trail head parking lot is approximately 35 min (18.2 miles) via Wrights Lake Rd.:

- 1. From Camp Cody Parking lot take Cody Meadow Rd, Pack Saddle Rd and Pack Saddle Pass to US-50 West in Twin Bridges - approximately 24 min (5.6 mi)**
- 2. Turn left onto US-50 West to Wrights Lake turn-off on right (north) side of Hwy 50 – approximately 5 min (3.6 mi).**
- 3. Continue on Wrights Lake Road to Lyons Lake trailhead - approximately 15 min (4.0 mi)**

Hiking directions: Lyons Creek Trail is a 12.3 mile heavily trafficked out and back trail located near Twin Bridges, California that features a lake and is rated as difficult. The trail is primarily used for hiking, camping, and backpacking and is best used from May until October. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash.

Length: 12.3 mi Elevation gain: 2,286 ft Route type: Out & back
